VENUES

Burabay 2023 International Orienteering Tournament will take place in Burabay Resort Area, North Kazakhstan. Mountains covered with a relict pine forest, majestic cliffs, clear lakes and clean air make this place one of the most beautiful corners of Kazakhstan. The nearest city is Schuchinsk (15 km). The distance to Astana is 220 km, to Almaty – 1200 km, West Siberia regions of Russia – 200-300 km.

VISA

May require a visa to enter to Kazakhstan territory for citizens of other States. Full information about entry rules and visa requirements see <u>here</u>.

TRANSPORT

Airport Astana (NQZ) is directly connected with Moscow, Tyumen, Novosibirsk, Kazan, Sochi (RUS), Istanbul, Ankara, Antalya (TUR), Dubai, Abu-Dabi (UAE), Frankfurt-am-Main (GER), Warsaw (POL), Kutaisi (GEO), Baku (AZE), Minsk (BLR), Tashkent (UZB), Bishkek (KGZ), Almaty, Aktau, Shymkent and many other cities of Kazakhstan. You can take a <u>train</u>, bus or taxi from Astana to Kurort-Borovoye Railway Station. Use low cost taxi or rent a car or van during the Event. COMPETITION RULES, CLASSES AND ENTRY REGULATIONS

The Competition Rules according with Orienteering Federation of the Republic of Kazakhstan Rules will be applied.

- There is classes for women and men: WM10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 21E, 35, 45, 55, 65, 70+, Beginners
- Some classes could be joint if number of athletes will 5 or less
- All competitions are individual
- The winner in each class is determined by the sum of the time of all five races

ENTRY

Should make entry with Orgeo.ru or by e-mail <u>nbk.12@mail.ru</u> or by phone +77772412424. Entry will be closed 17:00 April 26th, 2023 (Astana time zone). Late entry (via request to Event Office after April 26th) cost 200 percent of normal price.

ENTRY FEE

Per person for one race (at the exchange rate in tenge):

- ➢ MW 10, 12, 14, Beginners 4 euros
- > MW 16, 18, 55, 65, 70 5 euros
- ▶ MW 20, 21, 45, 50, 55 6 euros

Entry fee can be paid in the Event Center.

PUNCHING SYSTEM

SPORTident punching system will be used. You can use personal SI-chip of any series. Also it's possible to rent a chip from the organizers. It cost 1 euro per 1 race (at the exchange rate in tenge). In case of lose the rented chip, the team representative or the participant himself reimburses it's cost.

CLIMATE

at the midday $+5+20\Box$, at the midnight $0+15\Box$, mostly sunny.

TERRAIN AND MAPS

Mixed forest with a predominance of conifers. Forest cover is 95%. The relief is hilly, stones, rockes. Many small clearings, paths and various buildings. The maximum hill climb up to 60 meters. Scale 1:10000, contour interval 5 m, ISOM-2017 Symbol Set used, non-offset printed.
